PERFORMANCE INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL





Play the harmonic over the given base fingering (harmonic note-head) and trill the indicated keys in rapid succession, unpredictably, *ad libitum*. The RH 2 is continuously trilled while the LH 2 and 3 keys are broken and irregular. This creates pitch interference, which is a welcome result, but the performer should aim to maintain the notated harmonic for the majority of the note duration.

Rapid double or triple tonguing over the given base fingerings, with unpredictable sounding results within the range of the 1st and 2nd octaves, *ad libitum*



Bisb./Double bisb.

Trill a closely related key to create a bisbigliando effect. When two rows of trills are given, trill 2 or more keys in rapid alternation for increased speed.

rolling tone



This only applies to the oboe and bassoon. The rolling tone is a beating tone which is achieved either by manipulating the embouchure or with a fingering, which might be a very close microtonal dyad that includes the given pitch.

voice

At the end of the piece, the members of the orchestra sing concert C or C4 in unison. For the clarinet, this is written in Bb (D4), but should match the tones of the other instrumentalists.
